





3rd Call for Proposals

To be launched soon!



Two step approach:

- ❖ 1st step: submission of a short Expression of Interest (and if successful)
- ❖ 2nd step: submission of a complete Application Form

Call budget: approximately 60M EUR (ERDF, IPA, ENI)

Max project duration: 30 months
